"The simple fact that Meyer Sound equipment is self-powered enables us to accelerate our installation schedule by 12 weeks," says Sintow. "The UPA-1P's were installed in eight days. If we'd done that with unpowered speakers, that alone would have taken about six weeks."

The Meyer Sound system includes 70 MILO® high-power curvilinear array loudspeakers and 84 UPA-1P compact wide coverage loudspeakers, which according to Sintow, "simply disappear into the ceiling." Performance of the system can be checked at any time with a glance at Meyer Sound's RMS™ remote monitoring system.

The installation will be completed in July 2006, with the stadium's opening slated for August. With its ground-breaking media systems complementing the retractable roof, high-tech air conditioning and noteworthy architecture, Cardinals Stadium is sure to become a model for the way other sports facilities think about, plan, and implement their audio, video, and broadcast systems in the future.
