We're not just painting wood, but also plastic, metal, mesh—and each of these requires a different type of paint to ensure the components all look the same. Our paintwork is a protection system that we apply from the base coat to the top coat for both standard and non-standard colors, and all elements including ultra weather protection where applicable, are thoroughly tested using internationally known methodologies to ensure durability and consistency. We do both appearance and performance tests that look at adhesion, corrosion resistance, and elasticity.
